Principal's Report---- Ms. Morgan

- School enrollment is 860 students. This is a drop from last year of about 70-80 students.
- There has been a cut in office staff. The school is open until 4 o'clock with limited staffing.
 - The school welcomes volunteers.
- On November 23rd there is a Parent Forum. Safety will be the main topic. They will discuss emergency lock downs, safety procedures, and food allergy precautions.
- School apologized for the lock down happening on Oct 29th without notice. However, the school was only given two days' notice to complete the drill.
- Customer Satisfaction Survey
 - This is being put up on the website next week.
 - We need the feedback
 - Parents are going to be encouraged to take the survey after their parent teacher conferences.
 - Students will be taking them during their computer classes.
- ICE comments- Please send your good comments to ICE. It is nice to let everyone know what we are doing well.
- Memorandum of Understanding- this is something all volunteers need to sign to work in the school.
- There will be Red Cross training for all volunteers.

Facility Report--Chad Lucy

- There are strict guidelines for completing projects when students are not at the school.
- This can be challenging for the contractors and getting projects completed in a timely manner.
- The bathrooms are being renovated to make them appropriate for little people.
- Plumbing work is scheduled for November 6th, when we students are not in school.
- There was a sewage problem but this issue was resolved in 4 hours, which was a short amount of time. There was a lot of cooperation to resolve this issue quickly so that no students were affected.
- Most facility issues are resolved in the summer but unfortunately this summer no work was done.

- Pedestrian crosswalks are an issue, not just the guarded ones.
 - Drivers need to stop at crosswalks. We all need to pay more attention.

Cafeteria issues

- Linda Mahlquest (NEX representative) spoke about meeting with the high school SAC and discussing the size of the school lunches.
 - The hospital dietitian approves the school lunches and portion size.
 - The lunches are meeting the guidelines.
 - She observed a lunch at the school and noted that 70% of the fresh pears and apples were thrown away. So we can offer healthy choices we cannot force the students to eat them.
