EARLY MORNING LINE-UP BY GRADE LEVEL

Every morning before school your children will be lining up outside the building before the bell rings.

GRADES 2,3 AND 6

Will line up in the MPR (cafeteria) upon entering the building. These students enter through the cafeteria door to the left of the main entrance.

GRADES 4 AND 5

will head toward the 4th grade atrium and line up there

GRADE 1 will line up in the first grade hallway (front atrium).

Registration Advice For New Families And Their Sponsors

Students registered by 11:00 begin classes the following day, unless the parent requests a later date. Any student registering after 11:00 **will not start** until the second school day.

For Example; A family registers at 11:01 on Monday, the student will start Wednesday.
