# Principal's Corner



Dear Parents,

Many of you have already established back-to-school routines for your children. For those of you, who may be still looking at creating a continuous home-school learning environment, check out the suggestions below:

1. Make a plan: Schedule adequate time for homework, clubs, sports etc.
2. Scale back TV time.
3. Establish a family reading time.
4. Reestablish bed times for school nights.
5. Keep a large calendar: Mark each family member's activities in a different colored pen.
6. Ensure that your child has lunch tickets or a lunch each day.
7. Collect important phone numbers: Update doctor, work and other listings for the school office, after-school programs and one or two neighbors as emergency contacts.
8. Spruce up a study space for your child: Include pens, pencils, a dictionary and other needed supplies. Make the study space special; leaving an encouraging note and healthy treats.
9. Set up a file for school papers in case you need them for future references.

Get your children in the habit of getting ready the night before school. Set out clothes, pack lunches and put the backpacks by the front door.

**IMPORTANT:** Ensure that your child has lunch tickets or a BAG lunch each day. NES NO LONGER HAS A LUNCH BORROWING PROGRAM.

## RECOMMENDED IDEAS

\_\_ **1. Do you read** with your child every day and allow your child to choose the books sometimes, then talk about what you read, predict what may happen, etc.?

\_\_ **2. Do you explore** the world by taking walks and drawing what you see, closing your eyes and imagining what's before you, etc.?

\_\_ **3. Do you encourage** creativity by telling stories and moving to music together, adding your own ending, acting out the characters, etc.?

\_\_ **4. Do you play** skill-building games, such as following directions in "Simon Says," filling in missing words, numbers, days of the week, etc.?

\_\_ **5. Do you make** math fun by counting interesting objects...looking at pattern...estimating amounts, etc.?
