### OFT Anti-Bullying T-Shirt

The Overseas Federation of Teachers (OFT) wanted to embrace the movement to educate students about bullying and help them deal with situations involving bullies. Last spring OFT coordinated a poster contest for the students at Naples Elementary School, with the hopes that students process and internalize what bullying is and how to combat it. They were to create a poster with a slogan and picture to depict the anti-bullying message. The winner of the poster contest was sixth grader, Natalie Mitchell.

The winning poster was printed on T-shirts for OFT to sell as a fundraiser, and to pass the anti-bullying message in our Naples community. October 12 was Unity Day Against Bullying at N. E. S. Many staff members and students wore their T-shirts and the color orange to show their support of this important initiative. 
