### A Note From the Gym

Attention Parents!

Please be sure that your child is dressed appropriately for PE. Students should be wearing loose fitting, weather appropriate clothing that is easy to move in. Shoes should be athletic shoes with Velcro closures or shoe laces. Please, no jeans, dresses, boots, or flats. Students must come to school dressed and ready for PE. Remember, students do NOT have time to change clothes or shoes at school for PE. (They will miss out on either classroom instruction or PE instruction). The temperature in the gym fluctuates with the temperatures outside. Please be sure that students are dressed in layers since they do get warm when they are moving around in the gym. Beginning on Monday, November 5<sup>th</sup> (the first day of 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter) classes that are ALL dressed appropriately for gym will earn a "shoe" for their class. These shoes will be displayed in the gym. When a class earns 10 shoes, they will earn a reward day in PE class. Please be sure to keep track of the current specials calendar. Classroom teachers inform parents of specials days differently, so please check with your child's teacher or check their website.

"Have they changed"? Teachers and parents can both encourage their child during this time. Talk with the child about their excitement and concerns. Special events to celebrate the return should be planned. Welcome home signs, having the deployed parent's favorite meal and involving the parent in a school project are ideas that could be done. There may be some stress related to the return so assure the children this is normal and that it may take some time to get back into the new routine. After things have settled down, the post deployed parent should sit down and talk about school and how they can be involved.. The parent who stayed should encourage their children to seek help from both parents since they are used to going only to the one who stayed home. The returning parent needs to discuss school, school activities and other community activities so the child knows it is important to that parent.
