Hi, everyone

Last week I talked about predeployment & how to help your child ahead of the parent actually being deployed. Today, it is about the deployment time itself.

The most important thing a parent who is deployed can do is stay in touch. This gives you a feeling of connection to family. By asking about homework, tests and other school activities your child can stay focused on education. The parent still at home needs to talk about the deployed parent every day. Questions could be liked "What is daddy or mommy doing right now?" "Do you think mom or dad would like this food or book?". Younger children may need a way to help them understand how long deployed parent will be gone. Maybe a paper chain with each day being a link or fill a basket with Hershey's kisses and each day you eat a kiss from that parent. If the date changes adjust the link or basket while the child is not there. Phone calls to or from the deployed parent could help with a an assignment or talking about an activity they are in such as a school play, concert or game. You might say to the child "You know daddy is really good with history or science, let's ask him the next time we talk".

These are only examples of what can be done. Later we will talk about when dad or mom comes home.
